Dogs are allowed off leash in the open areas of Kakamatua beach and foreshore but must on a leash on the track leading to the beach. Where the bush ends and the creek comes into view, the terrain widens to show off some spectacular west coast scenery. Please join us at the beautiful spot. This spot has become very popular with doggie folk, hence our early start time.

Where: Kakamatua Inlet, Huia Road, Waitekere Ranges. Good signage on the left approx.. 200m past Cornwallis Road. 10min from Titirangi (great cafés).

Parking for 20 plus cars.

Further parking available on the main road but be careful – road is narrow and windy - keep dogs and yourself safe.

Meet in the carpark **8:50am heading out shortly after.**

Time: As long, or brief, as you want.

Dog bins: Several along the track leading to the beach and foreshore.

What to take

For Doggie(s): There is stream water for dogs to drink, but consider your travel time as well. Poo bags.

For you: Most footwear will do, but keep in mind you'll probably get your feet wet.
