DIRECTIONS: Take the Motorway North and come off at Oteha Valley Road, turn right and follow Oteha Valley Road until it reaches the traffic lights. Go straight ahead into Carlisle Road and follow the signs through Torbay to Long Bay. The park access road leads off Beach Road. Go across the little footbridge and turn right into the parking area. Please keep a look-out for other goldie people who will be milling around, and please keep your dogs on leads until we get to the beach. Once we get to the beach, the dogs are allowed to run free.



THE WALK: For those who have not been before, it is a wonderful spot and doggy heaven. The walk is approx. one hour – from parking area to the end of the beach and back but you can make this as long or as short as you want. The walk will go ahead regardless of the weather as we all know goldens and their owners are a hardy lot and don't mind being out in the rain and/or wind.

WALK FINISH: At the carpark. Please bring your own tea or coffee (in a thermos) or cold drink for morning tea. The club will provide muffins and savouries.

WHAT TO BRING:

- A drink for you and plenty of fresh water for your dogs, as all the racing around and swimming will make them very thirsty!
- Towels for your dogs, and
- Plastic bags to clean up after your dogs. There are no bins provided at the reserve and all rubbish, including doggie-do bags, must be taken away.
