Dog Walk at Long Bay Beach, Sunday 8th May 2016, 10:00 am.

Directions: Take the Motorway North and come off at Oteha Valley Road, turn right and follow Oteha Valley Road until it reaches the traffic lights. Go straight ahead into Carlisle Road and follow the signs through Torbay to Long Bay. The Park access road leads off Beach Road. Go across the little bridge and then right again into the parking area. Please keep a look-out for other goldie people who will be milling around. We will set off just after 10:00am.

Please keep dogs on leads until we get to the beach and please bring plastic bags to clean up after your dogs. There are no bins provided at the reserve and all rubbish including doggie-do bags must be taken away.

Once we get to the beach, the dogs are allowed to run free. For those who have not been before, it's a wonderful spot and doggy heaven. The walk is approx. one hour - from parking area to the end of the beach and back but you can make this as long or as short as you want.

Don't forget to bring plenty of fresh water for your dogs. The racing around and swimming will make them very thirsty.
